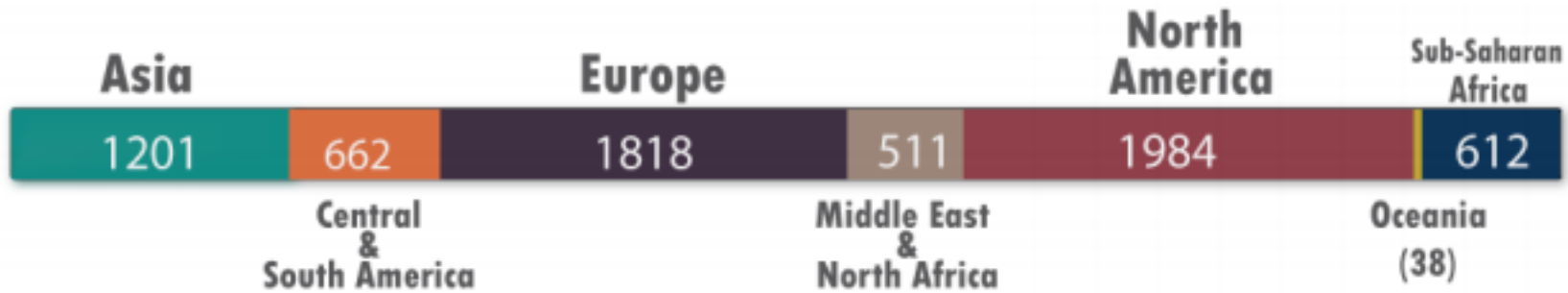

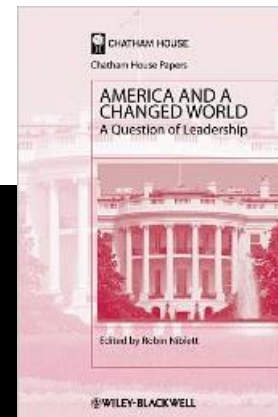

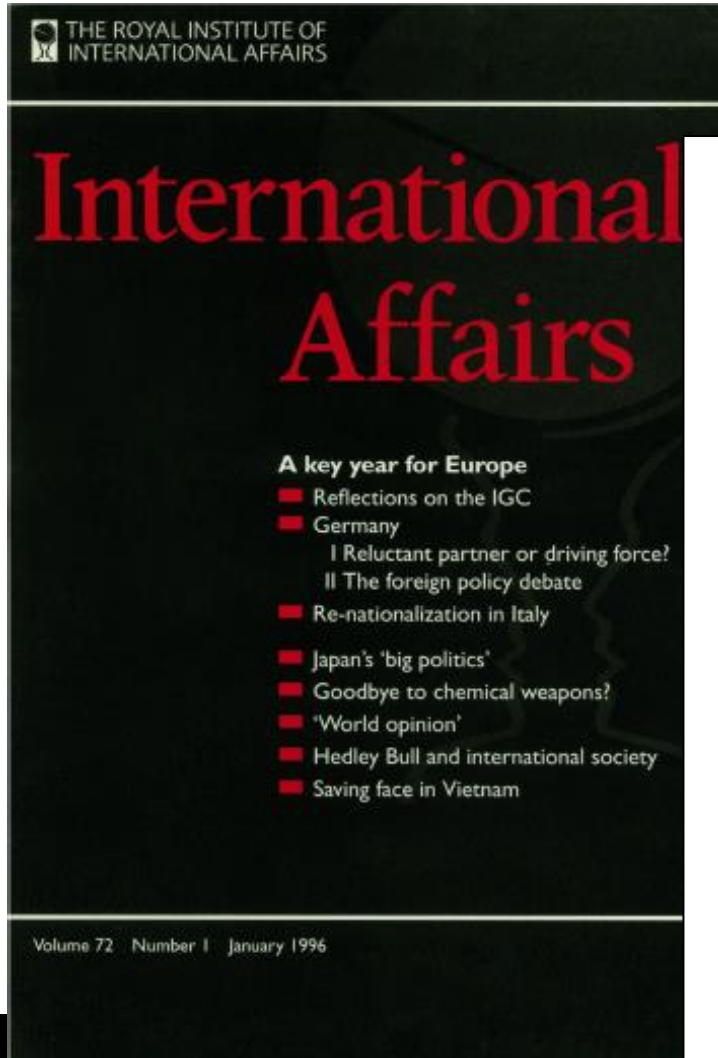

The revival of 'big politics'

in Japan

KIYOHICO FUKUSHIMA

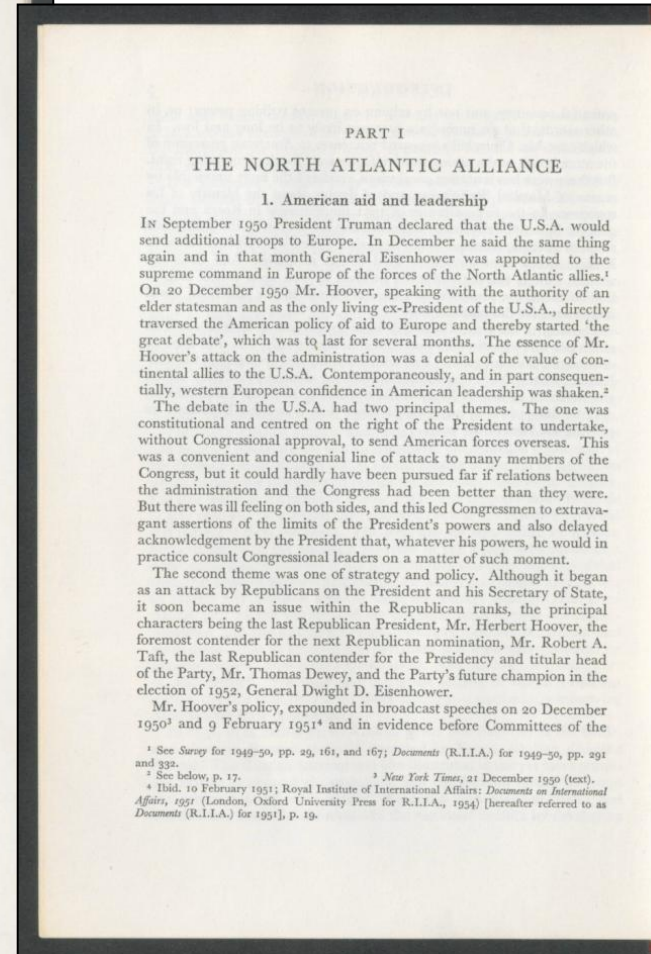
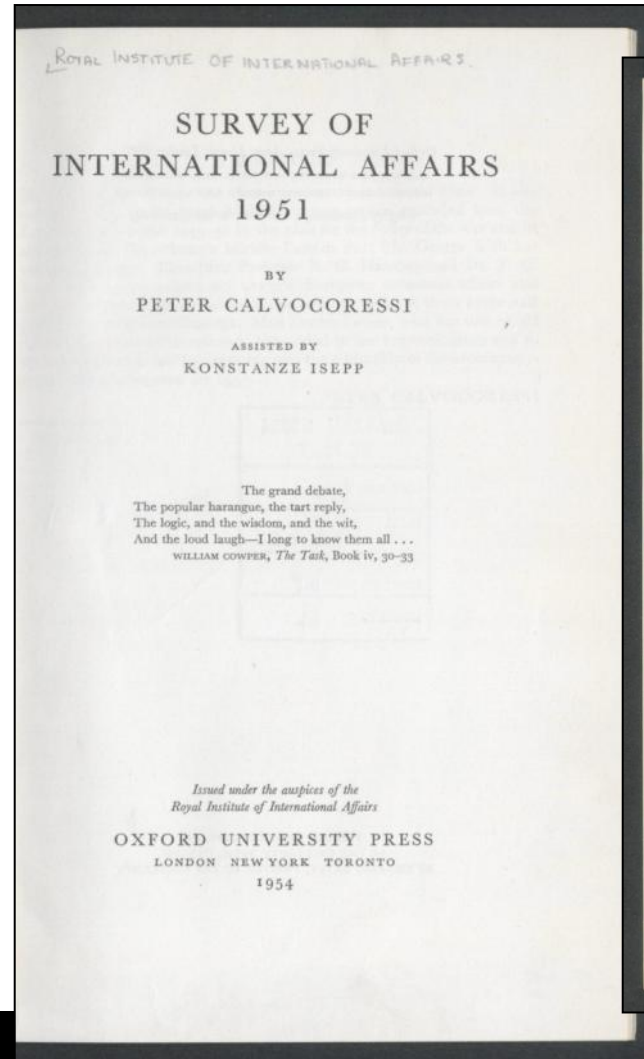
Politics', with sweeping domestic political and economic reform and a new vision in world affairs, has arrived in Japan. The Liberal Democratic Party's power has been broken, and the old multi-member constituencies and the pork-barrel style of politics are gone for good. Voters now want to elect a government of uncorrupt, reform-oriented, non-socialist political forces. The Democratic Party and the Liberal Democratic Party, which could come to power, represent 'consumers' and 'producers' interests, respectively, have gained a great deal of support. The forthcoming general election and the manner in which Japan's political process will undoubtedly have a global impact.

There has recently been an unprecedented flurry of 'vision' books by political analysts, each with its own distinctive catchphrases. Morihiro Hosokawa, the prime minister, from August 1993 to April 1994, for one, sees Japan on its 'third opening up', the first having begun with Commodore Perry's visit to Japan in 1853 and the second with Japan's 'opening up' in 1853 and 1854.¹ Current global conditions, Hosokawa argues, are forcing Japan to play a greater international role and to engage more with the outside world. The new prime minister, Ichiro Ozawa, officially the number two but in fact the man in the New Frontier Party (NFP, Shinshintō), Japan will 'open up to the world as a global country'.² By this he means it will be able to send its armed forces overseas under the auspices of the United Nations just like any other country. Japan will be free of the constraints of the outdated 1947 constitution. The new prime minister, Masayoshi Takemura, head of the Harbinger Party (Kigake) and the current finance minister, sees Japan as 'a shining country making a significant contribution to resolving the world's problems'.³ Ryutaro Hashimoto, the minister for international

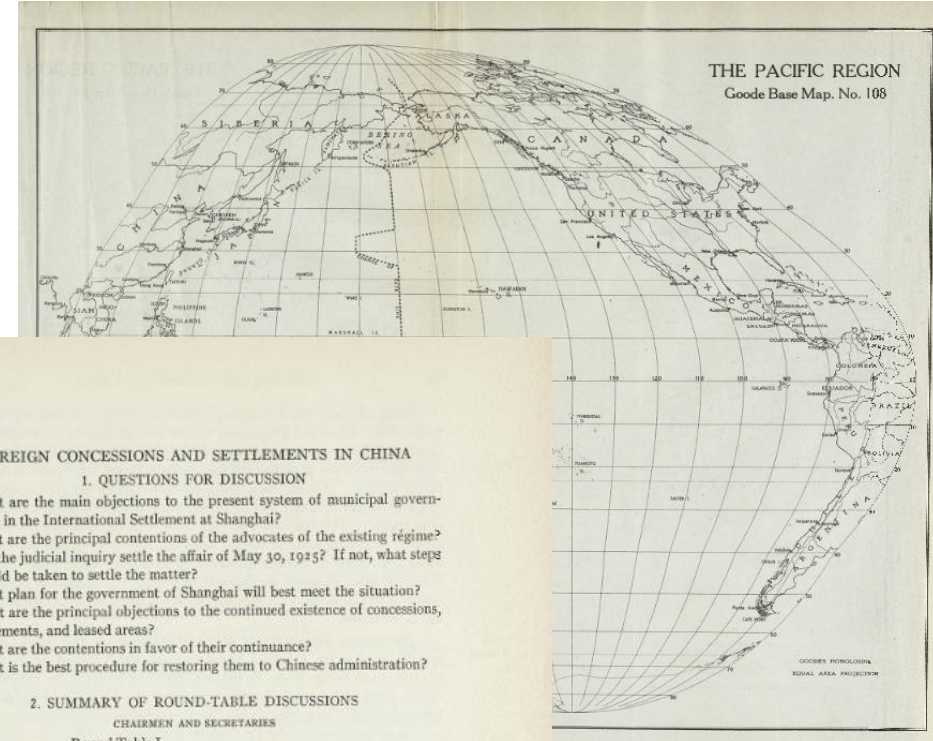
